Professor Weis is an international leader in the geochemistry of the Earth and its environment. She directs the world-class Pacific Centre for Isotopic and Geochemical Research that is also a training hub for future generations of scientists. She is internationally recognized for her insightful research on the chemical and isotopic composition of Earth's mantle with major impact on our understanding of the world's major Large Igneous Provinces, mantle plumes, and arcs.
